

1ST AMENDMENT PETITION FOR REDRESS OF CONSTITUTIONAL VIOLATIONS

To Restore Accountability & Justice for All through RULE-OF-LAW Grand Jury Rights

Pursuant to Articles I, III, IV, V, VI, and the Fifth, Tenth, and Fourteenth Amendments of the United States Constitution:

We, the undersigned citizens of the United States and residents of:

Exercise our right under the First Amendment to petition our government—including councils, courts, & **sheriff**—for redress of constitutional violations and restoration of Grand Jury Rights.

As guaranteed by the **Fifth Amendment** and reaffirmed in the 1992 United States v. Williams decision, Justice Scalia declared:

- **“The Grand Jury is an institution separate from the courts, over whose functioning the courts do not preside...”**
- **“...The Grand Jury serves as a ‘protector of citizens against arbitrary and oppressive governmental action.’”**

We demand that the elected sheriff uphold their constitutional duty by facilitating **RULE-OF-LAW non-government citizen Grand Jury oversight**, to ensure the just redress of grievances as supported by our Constitutions and the Supreme Court of the United States.

Officials who fail to uphold the Constitution, as bound by their oath, are subject to removal under Section 3 of the Fourteenth Amendment. Upon removal, an immediate election must ensure the selection of a sheriff committed to restoring **RULE-OF-LAW Grand Jury Rights**.
