

March 13, 2025 speech to the Virginia Beach Human Rights Commission

"Great afternoon, members of the Virginia Beach Human Rights Commission.

I stand before you today because justice is the backbone of human rights. Without accountability, human rights are nothing more than words on paper—easily ignored, easily trampled.

That is why we formed the Virginia Beach People's Grand Jury Oversight Committee—to restore rule-of-law oversight by the people, for the people. We have formally submitted a demand to local and federal authorities, insisting that the grand jury—our last line of defense against government overreach and corruption—be returned to the citizens as the Founders intended.

This is not just about Virginia Beach. This is about a fundamental human right: the right to justice, the right to truth, and the right to hold power accountable. Our work will serve as a model nationwide, ensuring that no one—no official, no institution—is above the law.

I invite this Commission to recognize and support this initiative, because justice is not just a legal matter—it is a human right. Thank you."
